- Please be sure to fill out the form **completely**.
- **Original art only**. Please do not submit art that was previously submitted.
- Please limit your entry to three pieces of art per person.
- Art must be delivered to Hope School **April 19, 3-8 pm, or April 20, 8 am-noon**. Art must be picked up at the end of the exhibit Saturday evening between 7-8 pm.
- Please have your art 'display ready' (for example: matted, framed, on poster board, etc.) Forms of display available at the school are wall hooks, tables, peg boards, etc. We will do our best to display your art in a satisfying manner. If you have your own display in mind, please indicate this on the front of this form. Also, if you have any special display requirements or wish to SET UP your own display, indicate this also.
- If you would like to sell your art as part of our fundraiser, you may do so. **YOU ARE NOT REQUIRED TO PUT YOUR ART UP FOR SALE!** If you are willing to sell your art, at least 50% of the sale price must be donated to Hope School Circle. If your art is sold, the art must remain at the event until it closes at 7 pm.
- Art will be judged by those attending the fundraiser. Winners will be chosen by 'popular vote'. There will also be prizes for special categories, determined by the committee. (For example, most unique art, top high school artists, etc.)
- The committee reserves the right to reject any art that is objectionable in nature or design. We ask that you remember that this event is an occasion to glorify God.
- The committee will do our best to keep your art 'safe'. However, please keep in mind that this event will be open to families and children will be present. If your art is 'invaluable', you may want to be present during the event to care for your own art and ensure its safety. We ask for your understanding in this regard.
