As we begin another journey through the Psalms, take a walk with the children through the Bible to identify who sang in these passages: Exodus 15, Deuteronomy 32 & 33, Numbers 21:17, Judges 5, II Samuel 6:5, 14, 16, II Chronicles 29:28-30, Nehemiah 12:42, Acts 16:25, Job 38:7, and Revelation 5:11-13. Then sing with the children Psalter #1, the well-known versification of Psalm 1.

- 2. Yea, blest is he who makes God's law His portion and delight, And meditates upon that law with gladness day and night.
